Highlights from Project Dance Paris, CDFB, Psalto and ICDF Norway Conferences



Paris is a city full of contrasts. Romance, fine dining, stunning architecture, and beauty, but some streets are filthy, and the odours are not pleasant. Many residents live in poverty and some even live with the shame of slavery. There is a spiritual battle for souls, and this is the backcloth to the staging of Project Dance.

Many years ago Cheryl Cutlip was given a vision to bring hope and joy onto the streets of New York. Then the vision grew, and now many cities receive the gift of Project Dance. Even before the dancers arrived, an intercessory team had prepared the ground. Then dancers travelled from many countries and gave of their time and money. They sacrificially brought gifts of joy, hope, and love to the people of Paris and the many visitors who are drawn to this amazing metropolis in the summer months.

The stage in the Place de Republic hosted dance from a variety of genres, including contemporary, ballet, street, and interpretive flags. Each dancer gave their movement as an offering to bless the city and its inhabitants.

In the evening, the dancers joined YWAM (Youth With A Mission) on the plaza overlooking the Eiffel Tower. As the heat of the day diminished and the natural light faded, crowds gathered to get the best view of the iconic tower, as it glittered and sparkled, like diamonds in a velvet black sky. This was the backdrop to a time of dance and worship, releasing hope and joy and supporting the work of YWAM as they shared the gospel.

The following day, they gathered in the studios to worship and learn together and shared the experiences of the previous day. The dance family came together, building relationships that reached beyond this event. Many of the dancers left changed and enriched. They gave so much but received even more.


